

## GENERAL RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The minimum standard riding hat is EN1384; Riding clubs recommends PAS015, which provides the greatest protection. All hats prefixed SE1/ASTM are acceptable. ASTM is NOT valid on its own; it MUST have the SE1 prefix. As a Riding club, anybody riding without a hard hat will be asked to leave the show ground.
2. Correct riding dress will be worn in all ridden events.  
  
All show jumping classes will be run under BSJA/Riding Club Rules.
3. Excessive use of whips or spurs or other maltreatment of an animal in or out of the ring will not be tolerated. Offenders will be liable to have their entries cancelled and they will be asked to leave the showground.
4. Any decision of any judge is final, subject to Rule 6.
5. Any objection may be lodge with the Secretary within one hour of the event, accompanied by a deposit of £10, which will be forfeited if the objection is over-ruled.
6. The Committee reserve the right to cancel, add to or amend any of the Classes as may be considered necessary.
7. No horse or pony under the age of 4 years should be ridden in show jumping or dressage classes.
8. The Committee will bear no responsibility for any injury, loss or damage arising from any cause on or in the vicinity of the showground. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that each competitor shall agree to indemnify the Committee against any legal action arising from such an incident.
9. All classes may be limited at the Committee's discretion. No entry will be accepted without the correct fee. Late entries or entries on the day will only be accepted if the class is not full and will charged £1 extra.
10. Entries are accepted at the Committee's discretion.
11. ARE YOU A TRUE NOVICE? The committee reserve the right to refuse entry into any class that they do not feel a competitor is entitled to enter.
12. There will be a £1 contribution for First Aid facilities.
